MATERIALS:

2/3 yard Blender Marigold
1/2 yard Blender Candy
2/3 yard Gators
3/4 yard Blender Papaya
2/3 yard Blender Cut Grass
1/3 yard Shellabrate
3/4 yard Palms
1/2 yard Flamingos
1 yard Florida Toss Black, includes binding
1/4 yard or FQ Sandals
1/2 yard Blender Marechiaro
1/3 yard or FQ Blender Almond
3/4 yard Festivities

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. WOF - WIDTH OF FABRIC; RST - RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER; HST - HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

THIS QUILT IS MADE COMPLETELY OUT OF 6" HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES (HST).

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From Blender Marigold Fabric:

Cut [6] — 10-1/2" squares (A)

From Gators Fabric:

Cut [6] — 10-1/2" squares (B)

From Blender Cut Grass Fabric:

Cut [6] — 10-1/2" squares (C)

From Palms Fabric:

Cut [3] — 10-1/2" squares (D)

Cut [1] — 14-1/2" square (E)

From Florida Toss Black Fabric:

Cut [1] — 10-1/2" square (F)

Cut [8] — 3" × WOF strips, binding

From Blender Marechiaro Fabric:

Cut [1] — 10-1/2" square (G)

Cut [1] — 14-1/2" square (H)

From Festivities Fabric:

Cut [3] — 10-1/2" squares (I)

Cut [2] — 14-1/2" squares (J)

From Blender Candy Fabric:

Cut [1] — 7-1/2" square (K)

Cut [2] — 14-1/2" squares (L)

From Blender Papaya Fabric:

Cut [1] — 7-1/2" square (M)

Cut [3] — 10-1/2" squares (N)

Cut [2] — 14-1/2" squares (O)

From Shellabrate Fabric:

Cut [4] — 10-1/2" squares (P)

From Flamingos Fabric:

Cut [2] — 14-1/2" squares (Q)

From Sandals Fabric:

Cut [1] — 7-1/2" square (R)

From Blender Almond Fabric:

Cut [1] — 7-1/2" square (S)

Cut [1] — 10-1/2" square (T)

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES ASSEMBLY (HST):


2-at-a-time HST

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of lighter of the 7-1/2" squares.
2. With RST, place [1] each of the pairs listed.
3. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line.
4. Cut on the drawn line. Press open and square up to 6-1/2".

Pair:

[1] Blender Almond square (S) with [1] Sandals square (R) = Yields [2] HSTs

[1] Blender Candy square (K) with [2] Blender Papaya squares (M) = Yields [2] HSTs




4-at-a-time HST

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of lighter of the 10-1/2" squares in both directions.
2. With RST, place [1] each of the pairs listed.
3. Sew 1/4" on all [4] sides of the square as shown.
4. Cut on both drawn diagonal lines. Press open and square up to 6-1/2".

Pair:

- [3] Blender Marigold squares **(A)** with [3] Gators square **(B)** = Yields [12] HSTs
- [3] Palms squares **(D)** with [3] Blender Cut Grass square **(C)** = Yields [12] HSTs, Use [10]
- [3] Gators squares **(B)** with [3] Blender Cut Grass square **(C)** = Yields [12] HSTs
- [1] Florida Toss Black square **(F)** with [1] Blender Marechiaro square **(G)** = Yields [4] HSTs
- [3] Festivities squares **(I)** with [3] Blender Marigold squares **(A)** = Yields [12] HSTs
- [3] Blender Papaya squares **(N)** with [3] Shellabrate squares **(P)** = Yields [12] HSTs, Use [9]
- [1] Shellabrate square **(P)** with [1] Blender Almond square **(T)** = Yields [4] HSTs




8-at-a-time HST

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of lighter of the 14-1/2" squares in both directions.
2. With RST, place [1] each of the pairs listed.
3. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn lines.
4. Cut horizontally and vertically.
5. Cut on both drawn diagonal lines. Press open and square up to 6-1/2".

Pair:

- [1] Palms square **(E)** with [1] Blender Marechiaro square **(H)** = Yields [8] HSTs
- [1] Festivities square **(J)** with [1] Blender Candy square **(L)** = Yields [8] HSTs; Use [7]
- [1] Festivities square **(J)** with [1] Blender Papaya square **(O)** = Yields [8] HSTs; Use [6]
- [1] Flamingos square **(Q)** with [1] Blender Candy square **(L)** = Yields [8] HSTs; Use [7]
- [1] Flamingos square **(Q)** with [1] Blender Papaya square **(O)** = Yields [8] HSTs; Use [5]



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Follow layout of HSTs as shown.
2. Sew [9] HSTs together to make [11] rows.
3. Sew rows together to make quilt top.



FINISHING:

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind.
4. Label & Enjoy!
